

Privacy Statement

Green Maritime respects your right to privacy and we take our related legal obligations seriously.

We aim to be transparent to you about our treatment of your information.

Our commitment

- 1. We comply with applicable privacy and data protection laws and regulatory frameworks.
- 2. We treat all Confidential Information as confidential and do not disclose the same to a third party.
- 3. We only ask you for personal information that is relevant to us supplying you with our services.
- 4. We only use your personal information to supply, improve and manage our services.
- 5. We ensure that all Confidential Information shall only be disclosed to officers, employees, contractors, legal advisers and accountants on a need to know basis. We do not give your personal information to our suppliers without your permission.
- 6. We do not use the Confidential Information other than is necessary for the purpose of performing our commitments or exercising our rights.
- 7. We ask for your permission to take photos or video which may include you but you will never be named if these are then used on our website or in any of our promotional materials. You are given the opportunity to opt out before photos are taken.
- 8. We will not share personally identifiable information with unrelated third parties for their own use without your consent.
- 9. We take appropriate steps to safeguard your information in accordance with industry standards. But no system can be guaranteed as completely secure and there is an inherent risk in transmitting information over the internet. It may be possible for an unrelated party to intercept or access such transmissions unlawfully. We protect against this as far as is possible. Please be aware that any information you do transmit to us is at your own risk.
- 10. We will only keep your information for as long as we need it. This may be for:
 - 1. providing you with a service
 - 2. improving our services and
 - 3. for legal and audit purposes.
- 11. We aim to give you control over the information we hold about you by enabling you to access, update and delete your information in-line with your legal rights.



Copyright, Photography and Audiovisual and other Recording
